Reports were given by LaRae Doorman (Ambulance Captain) the 501c3 is established, Ben Richwine (Fire Chief) and Betsy Seanor (DISS), County Commissioner Jim Traynor, Lisa Waskin from the Superior District Library.

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There was discussion about the Spark Grants being applied for, volunteers for updating the 5 year recreation plan, Geoff Berndt about coordinating the ambulance with Drummond Island Medical Clinic, Scott Danforth Lighthouse Church about paving the parking lot, signs telling tourist how dry the island is and that there is no burning because of the fire danger, and the Maxton property split request.
