REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Supervisor Cameron called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Supervisor Cameron called roll. Treasurer Stevenson, Clerk Havens, Trustee Kruzel, Trustee Matkovich and Supervisor Cameron were present.

Clerk Havens read the minutes of the June 6, 2023 regular meeting.

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel that the June 6, 2023 minutes be approved as read. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Treasurer Stevenson that the accounts payable in the amount of \$63,253.21 be approved. Motion carried 5-0

Brooke Milbrandt, Assessor gave report on June's activities.

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Treasurer Stevenson that the Drummond Island Township Board adopt a resolution "to allow the July and December Board of Review to meet on an alternate date, if/when necessary, during the same week as the regular meeting, being the week of the third Monday in July or the week of the second Monday in December." Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Kruzel, supported by Trustee Matkovich that the Land Division Application update be approved as presented. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Treasurer Stevenson that the Drummond Island Township Board approve a resolution for ballot language to be placed on the ballot for renewal of the general operating millage to be voted on during the November 7, 2023 election cycle. (This proposal will permit the Township to fully reinstate and continue the millage previously approved for the above purpose by the electors)

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on all taxable real and tangible personal property in Drummond Island Township, Chippewa County Michigan be increased by an amount not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for 6 years, being 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, 2029, inclusive, for the purpose of providing additional operating funds for township general operating purposes (this being a re-instatement of a general operating millage which expired with the 2023 levy) within the

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township and shall the township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$143,603? Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzel that Georgiana Potter's name be added to the list of eligible election workers. Motion carried 5-0

Reports were given by LaRae Dorman (Ambulance Captain) Lyne Coulter (DISS), County Commissioner Jim Traynor, Julie Stevenson (Treasurer) gave an update on interest earned for the 2nd quarter, Geoff Bernd gave an update on Clinic/Ambulance coordination, and a written report from the golf course.

There was discussion about the 2 Spark Grants that have been applied for, pickle ball courts at the golf course are almost ready, signs need to be put up at ball field (no dogs allowed), other grants that could be applied for and the need for a plan for use of the hall during power outages.

Moved by Clerk Havens supported by Trustee Kruzel that the meeting be adjourned at 7:29 p.m. Motion carried 5-0
