Treasurer Potter announced that she would be retiring after 22 years as of September 30, 2022.

There was discussion about the park manager position. Applicants had until July 29, 2022 to submit letters of interest, resumes and/or applications. Due to the number of qualified applicants and the absence of the previous park manager tonight the appointment will be made at a later date.

There was discussion about the fishing pier at the township park. The accessibility of the fishing pier at the Betsy Seaman Park was also mentioned.

Today is Primary Election Day. Clerk Havens left the meeting at 6:55 because of election duties.
