Supervisor Cameron called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Supervisor Cameron called roll. Treasurer Stevenson, Clerk Havens, Trustee Kruzel, Trustee Matkovich and Supervisor Cameron were present.

Clerk Havens read the minutes of the July 6, 2023 regular meeting.

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Treasurer Stevenson that the July 6, 2023 minutes be approved as read. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Clerk Havens that the accounts payable in the amount of \$69,242.06 be approved. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Clerk Havens that the Community Fireworks budget be increased from \$15,000 to \$17,289.96. Motion carried 5-0

Ben Richwine gave a fire department report and thanked the community and Homemakers for the fund raiser. The department had 5 runs and Ben assisted with a Detour fire.

Other reports were given by Lynn Coulter (DISS), LaRae Dorman (Ambulance Captain), Pam Ellis (retired Ambulance Captain) on her attendance at Kinross meetings, a written golf course report was given, and the need for input into the 5 Year Recreation Plan was shared.

After the report and presentation by LaRae Dorman it was moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzel that the "EMS Paid On Call" schedule for the balance of the 2023/24 fiscal year be approved as presented. Motion carried 5-0

The action on a request from DITA to use the ball field for the Fall Festival was postponed because there questions from the board and there were no representatives from DITA to answer them.

There was community discussion about dust control for Cream City Pt. Rd., and park patrons control. Chloride has been ordered and will be available for pick up after tomorrow for dust control. Toni San Martin volunteered to head a committee to research solutions to the park issue.

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Supervisor Cameron reported that he would be meeting with Gregg Postma, Chippewa County Emergency Services regarding a plan for use of the town hall during power outages.

Moved by Clerk Havens supported by Trustee Kruzel that the meeting be adjourned at 7:51 p.m.
