Supervisor Cameron called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Supervisor Cameron called roll. Treasurer Stevenson, Clerk Havens, Trustee Kruzel, Trustee Matkovich and Supervisor Cameron were present.

Clerk Havens read the minutes of the April 2, 2024 regular meeting.

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the April 2, 2024 minutes be approved as read. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that the accounts payable in the amount of \$128,828.11 be approved. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the Library Millage language for the August 6, 2024 ballot be for four (4) years for .5 mills be approved as presented. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Kruzel, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, , that the Road Millage language for the August 6, 2024 ballot be for four (4) years for 1 .5 mills be approved as presented. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the application for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July 4, 2024 from Derek Ledy be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Trustee Kruzel that the request for a liquor license transfer from DIO Liquor Holdings LLC be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Matkovich, that the park budget for 2024/25 be increased by \$5000 for accounting purposes only be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the request from DITA to use the township ball field for Fall Fest October 11 & 12, 2024 (same as last year) be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

There were reports from Supervisor Cameron (Library agreement, quote from Cloverland on the street light request at Old Ferry Rd (he will call MDOT), County blight ordinance, ferry dock bathrooms, park on site host, August 6, 2024 library and road millage language, Darlene Skinner/ GC Committee, Jim Traynor presented as list of County health care agencies and other county resources and ferry service,
