Supervisor Cameron asked Trustee Kruzel to lead the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Supervisor Cameron called roll. Treasurer Stevenson, Clerk Havens, Trustee Kruzel, and Supervisor Cameron were present. Trustee Matkovich was absent

Clerk Havens read the minutes of the June 4, 2024 regular meeting.

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the June 4, 2024 minutes be approved as read. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the accounts payable in the amount of \$33,619.42 be approved. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Trustee Kruzel, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that the Township annex a portion of the Eldon Seaman property adjoining the Betsy Seaman Park. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the board approve paying wages owed (\$3,345) but not submitted in the 2023/24 fiscal year be paid from the 2024/25 fiscal year budget. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the recommendation from the Golf Course Committee to define a family membership as "Member, spouse, significant other and children 18 and under" be approved starting with the 2024/25 golf season. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzel, that the Township approve the Library Service Agreement with Superior District Library as presented on the condition that a budget is provided. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that the suggested changes to the Township Use Policy be referred to Township Use Committee for review. Motion carried 4-0

Moved by Trustee Kruzel, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that the August 6, 2024 board meeting be moved to August 8, 2024 because of the August 6th election. Motion carried 4-0

Supervisor Cameron said that he had talked with the DNR about a bear study on the island. Ben Richwine/Fire Dept. reported that Andrew Truax and Nick Newell had been trained to repair and certify the air packs, that fire fighters were now trained to board freighters to fight fires, there was a roll over and 2 structure fires in June. Christina/DITA mentioned the Classic Golf Tournament and The Beach Party on July 3, 2024, George Johnson said that Sim's Point property owners would like the road to become a County road.

Moved by Trustee Kruzel, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that the meeting be adjourned at 6:55 p.m. Motion carried 4-0
