Supervisor Cameron asked Ambulance Captain LaRae Dorman to lead the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Supervisor Cameron called roll. Treasurer Stevenson, Clerk Havens, Trustee Kruzal, Trustee Matkovich and Supervisor Cameron were present.

Clerk Havens read the minutes of the May 7, 2024 regular meeting.

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzal, that the May 7, 2024 minutes be approved as read. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Trustee Kruzal, that the accounts payable in the amount of \$94,013.77 be approved. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Matkovich, supported by Treasurer Stevenson, that putting a street light at 134 and Old Ferry Rd for the cost of \$3,215.00 be approved. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Trustee Kruzal, supported by Trustee Matkovich, that Steve Gottschling, Golf Course Manager be given permission to deposit golf course revenue and receive the deposit receipt be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Treasurer Stevenson, supported by Trustee Kruzal, that John Keister be approved to apply for the Volunteer Fire Capacity Grant as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Trustee Matkovich, that John Keister be approved to apply for the Michigan DNR Forest Services Resource Grant as requested. Motion carried 5-0

Supervisor Cameron opened the one (1) sealed bid for tree trimming at the airport. Lynette Girard talked about a bidding process used in Emmet County, after much discussion, it was moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Trustee Kruzal, that the bid from Island Tree Service for \$14,000 be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0

After much discussion on the upgrades to our security systems it was moved by Clerk Havens, supported by Trustee Matkovich, that the proposal for Option A submitted by Insula Labs, LLC for the town hall/ambulance barn of \$6,529.00 be approved as requested. Motion carried 5-0
